

**ADAMAWA STATE HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY**

**A BILL**

**FOR**

**A LAW TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT THE ADAMAWA STATE DISTRICTS CREATION LAW, 2024 AND TO PROVIDE FOR MATTERS INCIDENTAL THERETO.**

Date of Commencement ( )

BE IT ENACTED by the House of Assembly of Adamawa State of Nigeria and by the Authority of same as follows: -

Short Title and Commencement

1. This Law may be cited as the Adamawa State Districts Creation Law 2024, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the .....<sup>5<sup>th</sup></sup>..... day of .....<sup>DEC</sup>..... 2024.

**PART I - PRELIMINARY**

Interpretation

2. In this Law unless the context otherwise requires: "Area of Authority" means village and any other places named and indicated to constitute a District under this Law;

"Council" means Emirate or Traditional Council in the State;

"Governor" means the Governor of Adamawa State of Nigeria;

"House" means House of Assembly of Adamawa State;

"Law" includes Edicts;

"State" means Adamawa State of Nigeria

## **PART II - CREATION AND FINANCIAL PROVISION**

Creation of Districts

3. There are hereby created for the State Districts to be known by the names in column B set forth opposite their respective Local Government Areas of Authority named in column A, the villages under the Districts in column C and their Headquarters named in column D of the schedule to this Law.

Powers and Functions of Council in Relation to Districts

4. Subject to this Law or any other Law that may be enacted by the House, the Council shall continue to exercise such administrative powers and perform such functions in respect of Districts as are contained in the Local Government Law 1994.

Financial Provisions

5. There shall be paid and credited to the District fund:-



- (a) Such monies as shall be credited to the District fund by the Local Government area or any other authority;
- (b) any grant or donation from any person, authority or organization.

**PART III - SELECTION, ELECTION,  
APPOINTMENT AND DEPOSITION  
OF DISTRICT HEADS**

Governor to  
Appoint District  
Heads

6. The Council shall have the power to forward names of candidates selected to the Governor for appointment as District Heads.

Procedure for  
Selection and  
Appointment of  
District Heads

7. The procedure for the selection and appointment of District Heads shall be in the following manner: -

- (a) Where traditional or customary methods of selecting a District Head exist:
  - (i) selection shall be in accordance with tradition and custom of the area constituting the District, in the presence of a representative of the Council and such security agents as the Council may request, organized and supervised by the Department of Chieftaincy Affairs and the Office

of the Secretary to the State Government respectively;

- ii. the representative of the Council shall within one week make a report in writing to the Council of the result of the selection;
- iii. on receipt of the report, the Council shall transmit the first three candidates selected in no particular order to the Governor for the appointment as the District Head;
- iv. the Council shall within one month of appointment take necessary steps to turban the District Head in a ceremony.

(b) Where no traditional method of selecting District Head exists, a vacancy exists, and applications are received by the Council to fill such vacancy. The Council shall: -

- i. Constitute a Screening Committee to screen the applicant(s), as only cleared candidates shall be eligible for selection;
- ii. constitute an Appeal Panel to hear complaints from the Screening Committee. Provided that any aggrieved aspirant shall within 2 days of the receipt of the screening



committee report, appeal to the Appeal Panel, who shall determine the appeal within two days of the receipt of the appeal;

- iii. upon receipt of the Screening Committee's or the Appeal Panel's report, the council shall arrange for the selection at the appointed date and time and save for security reasons the election shall be conducted at the Headquarters of the District.

(c) Arrange for the selection at an appointed date and time and save for security reasons the selection shall be conducted at the Headquarters of the District;

- i. the village Heads in the District shall be the selectors and the names of first three persons who scored the highest number of votes shall be forwarded by the Council to the Governor in no particular order for appointment as the District Head;
- ii. the selection shall be conducted in the presence of the representative of the Council, and such number of security agents as may be required by the Council, organized and supervised by the Department of

chieftaincy Affairs and the Office of the State Government respectively.

- iii. the representative of the Council shall within one week make a report in writing to the Council of the result of the selection and the council shall submit the first three names selected to the Governor for consideration as appointment as the District Head; and
- iv. the Council shall within one month take necessary steps to turban the District Head in a ceremony.

Aggrieved  
Persons

8. (1) Any aggrieved person who has sought to be selected or elected as a District Head or any Community aggrieved may within two weeks petition to the Council:

(2) The Council shall proceed to determine the petition and if reasonable grounds exist, a committee shall be set up to investigate the allegations raised in the petition and if established, the petition and report thereof shall be sent to the Governor for approval of the prayers or otherwise.

Eligibility for  
Appointment as  
District Head

9. (1) Where traditional method exists, the selectors shall determine the eligibility of the person according to tradition and custom provided such person has not been convicted of any criminal offence by a Court of Law.



(2) Where no traditional method exists, a person shall be qualified to contest the election if:

- (a) he is from a royal family from any of the village areas;
- (b) he is not less than 25 years;
- (c) he is an indigene;
- (d) he has not been convicted of any criminal offence;

(3) Provided always that when a village area does not have a royal family, then any person of respectable character and who commands the respect of his community shall be eligible to seek election as a District Head.

Remuneration of District Heads

10. The Governor shall have the power to fix and determine the remuneration of District Heads and it shall be the responsibility of the various Local Government Councils to pay the Districts Head in their jurisdiction, which shall from time to time be subject to review.

Appointment of Acting District Head

11. Where the office of a District Head becomes vacant for any reason whatsoever reason, the council may where necessary, appoint an Acting District Head for a period of not exceeding 6 months within which the substantive District Head must have been appointed.

Discipline of  
District Heads

12. (1) The Council shall have the power to discipline and deposed a District Head where the District Head is found to have mismanaged Government fund, engaged in any criminal activity and has been convicted for such a crime or for gross public misconduct or dereliction of duty.

(2) Where the Council deposes a District Head, the deposition shall be final and conclusive only if approved by the Governor and such approval shall be given within 30 days.

Repeal

13. The Adamawa State Districts Creation (Repeal and Re-enactment) Law No. 4 of 2022 is hereby repealed.


